Born in Yorkshire & having lived in the Canary Islands & the French Alps, Henrie is inspired largely by a love of vast expanses of nature and her varying surroundings, be it huge impressive skies, the coast, mountains, landscapes and sunsets or city scenes & architecture.

Her continual exploration of colour, depth & light, results in an eclectic series of paintings brimming with passion and energy, which she hopes, provoke an emotional experience. Haldane's paintings have been compared to both that of the great landscape artist Turner, to the abstract symbolist painter, Klimt.
